NUMERACY

Place Value: Reading, writing, ordering and rounding numbers.

Operations: Written addition, subtraction, multiplication and division calculations. We'll focus on dividing with remainders and what to do with them.

Mental Maths: Addition, subtraction and multiplication strategies. Choosing the most efficient strategy to solve a calculation.

Properties of Numbers: Factors, multiples, prime, square and cubed numbers. Breaking numbers down and rebuilding them.

Shape and Space: 2D shapes. Types of angles and turns. Interior and exterior angles. **Time:** Reading analogue and digital times.

Calculating time durations.

Christmas.

LITERACY

Grammar: Parts of speech (nouns verbs, adjectives, adverbs). Verb tenses. Proof reading tasks for punctuation. Prefixes and suffixes.

Reading: Pupils will be reading in groups and by themselves throughout the week. They will have a class reading book which is also read for homework. Pupils will be completing a range of comprehension activities based on fiction and non-fiction texts.

Some of our literacy will be based on our class novel, 'Chains' by Laurie Halse Anderson.

Writing: Recount, narrative, myth.

ICT

Desktop Publishing: Consolidation of basic skills including layout, text wrapping and digital pictures.

Desktop Organisation: Saving files, using cloud storage, sharing files with others. **Animation:** Using the program 'Scratch' to write increasingly complex computer script. If we have time we might have a go at Lego Movie Maker animation too, just before

THE WORLD AROUND US: USA

In P7, we cover a topic throughout a whole term. This is different from other years but allows us to really get 'stuck into' each topic we cover. Our term 1 topic is the USA. Up until half term we will be focusing on the following areas:

- Christopher Columbus and the discovery of the New World.
- Native Americans, including Pocahontas (did you know she was a real person?)
- Early colonists
